# LANDFILL SITE

NEW HOURS: Wednesdays 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and Saturdays 10:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

#### **BURN PILE:**

Acceptable Items

Wood

### Non-Acceptable Items

Vinyl siding, tarps, and plastic materials must be separated and disposed of in the household garbage bin.

Paint cans, oil, batteries, antifreeze or hazardous waste materials must be returned to the place of purchase.

Any metal products must be disposed of in the scrap metal area.

Vinyl and plastics emit toxic substances when burned.

Propane tanks may explode if burned.

#### **ASHPHALT SHINGLES BIN:**

Asphalt Shingles Wood shakes must be Tar Paper disposed of in the burn

pile.

Tin roofing materials must be placed in the scrap

metal area.

Residents and visitors are also reminded that the landfill site is for Tahsis use. Importing and disposing of appliances, vehicles, and refuse from other jurisdictions is prohibited.

## RECYCLING

#### **RECYCLING DEPOT:**

The Village of Tahsis has a recycling depot next to the Public Works Yard on North Maquinna Drive.

Bins are provided for the following:

Newspapers Aluminum Cans

Plastic Basic Household Garbage

Cardboard Milk Jugs

Mixed Paper

### **FREE STORE:**

An area at the Recycling Depot has been designated for a Free Store. Anyone disposing of items, that could be utilized by someone else, is encouraged to use the free store.

"Better that someone else may find the item useful than the item being buried at the landfill site."
