



Residents and visitors are reminded that they are required to dump refuse in the appropriate areas of the landfill site. The Village relies on the public to co-operate in managing the proper use of the landfill site.

By complying with a few basic rules, we can all assist in extending the life of the landfill site and protect the environment.

## ***LANDFILL SITE***

**NEW HOURS: Wednesdays 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.  
and Saturdays 10:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.**

### **BURN PILE:**

#### Acceptable Items

Wood

#### Non-Acceptable Items

Vinyl siding, tarps, and plastic materials must be separated and disposed of in the household garbage bin.

Paint cans, oil, batteries, antifreeze or hazardous waste materials must be returned to the place of purchase.

Any metal products must be disposed of in the scrap metal area.

*Vinyl and plastics emit toxic substances when burned.  
Propane tanks may explode if burned.*

## **ASHPHALT SHINGLES BIN:**

### Acceptable Items

Asphalt Shingles  
Tar Paper

### Non-Acceptable Items

Wood shakes must be disposed of in the burn pile.

Tin roofing materials must be placed in the scrap metal area.

## **HOUSEHOLD BIN:**

### Acceptable Items

Basic household garbage

### Non-Acceptable Items

Residents and visitors are encouraged to recycle the following:

Plastic  
Newspaper  
Cardboard  
Aluminum Cans  
Mixed Paper  
Milk Jugs

## **SCRAP METAL AREA:**

### Acceptable Items

Vehicles  
Hot Water Tanks  
Appliances  
Metal Roofing  
Propane Tanks

### Non-Acceptable Items

Household Garbage  
Hazardous Waste  
Wood  
Plastic, Vinyl, etc.

***Residents and visitors are also reminded that the landfill site is for Tahsis use. Importing and disposing of appliances, vehicles, and refuse from other jurisdictions is prohibited.***

# **RECYCLING**

## **RECYCLING DEPOT:**

The Village of Tahsis has a recycling depot next to the Public Works Yard on North Maquinna Drive.

Bins are provided for the following:

Newspapers  
Plastic  
Cardboard  
Mixed Paper

Aluminum Cans  
Basic Household Garbage  
Milk Jugs

## **FREE STORE:**

An area at the Recycling Depot has been designated for a Free Store. Anyone disposing of items, that could be utilized by someone else, is encouraged to use the free store.

“Better that someone else may find the item useful than the item being buried at the landfill site.”

## **HAZARDOUS WASTE: (to be taken back to the place of purchase)**

Items include:

Oil  
Paints

Batteries  
Antifreeze
